# Keep in mind: NEHS Elections coming up!



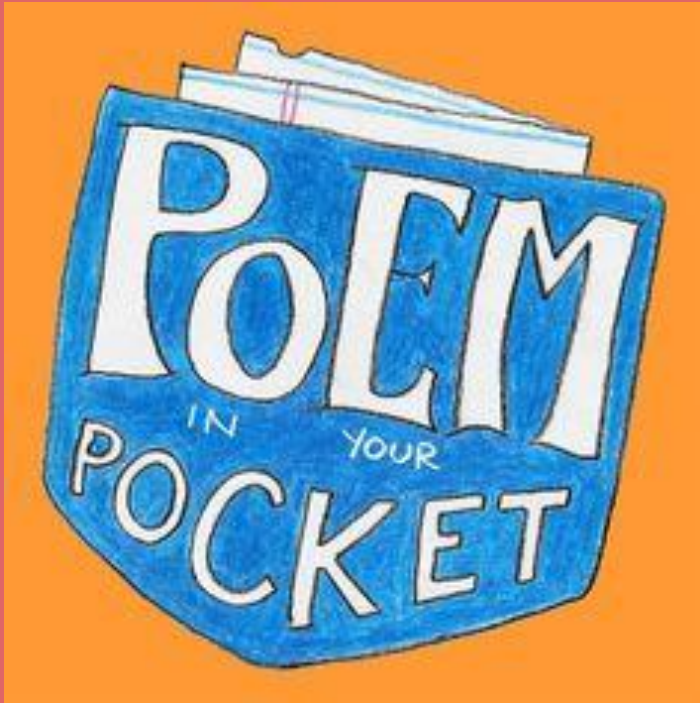
- If you are considering running for any position next year on the NEHS officer board, we encourage you to start talking to us now
