

NEHS Requirements


- ❖ **15 hours** required per year for all members
 - For *rising members*, *at least 5 of those 15 must be completed before December 10th, 10 by the end of February, and 12 by the end of 3rd quarter.*
 - General meetings count as an hour
 - Contribute videos to our online Kinder Reading Program!
 - Submit original poetry and prose to our literary journal, *the atala*
 - Submit to our featured monthly writing contests!
 - Participate in and attend events such as Recite Night and Poetry Slam!
 - Donate cookies or milk for Recite Night (see slide)
- ❖ Remember, both your **English and CUM GPA** must stay at a **3.0** or higher
 - Returning members must submit verification info if not done already!

- Receive 2 hours for submitting a video of yourself reading a level 1 book!
- Receive 2 hours for editing a video.
- Receive 4 hours if you submit an edited video of yourself reading a book!

- ★ Earn 2 NEHS hours for each of the following: ekphrastic, ode, parody poem, poem for two voices, sestina, sonnet, villanelle


Broward County Poet Laureate
